1. Introduction

1.4 Other than for Google Analytics cookies for which we seek your explicit consent, by using the ITCB® website you agree to our use of cookies in accordance with the terms of this Cookie Policy and the ITCB privacy notice.

2. About cookies

2.1 Cookies are small files that a site or its service provider transfers to your device's hard drive through your web browser, if allowed by you, and that enables the websites or service providers systems to recognize your browser and capture and remember certain information.

2.2 Cookies can be temporary or permanent. Temporary cookies are only temporarily stored in your browser or application. As soon as you close and leave your browser or application, those cookies will be deleted. Permanent cookies remain on your computer or mobile device, even if you close the browser or the application. Permanent cookies make it possible to recognize you during subsequent visits to the website or application. Permanent cookies remain on your device until their end date is reached, until a new cookie is installed, or until you delete them in your settings of your browser, application or mobile device.

2.3 First-party cookies are cookies that ITCB® manages and that are specific to the visited or used online service. Third party cookies are cookies that are managed and placed by a third party. This happens during your visit or use of

the website. Third party cookies ensure that certain information is sent to third parties by your visit to the website.

2.4 We do not ask your permission for the use of necessary cookies and functional cookies which are necessary for the operation of the website and to ensure that the website functions properly. However, the use of performance and analysis cookies and social media cookies require your consent which we collect via our cookie banner on the ITCB.org homepage. Performance and analysis cookies collect information about the way visitors use our website. This is done with the intention to improve the content of our websites, to further adapt it to the wishes of the visitors and to increase the usability of our websites. Websites may also implement so-called embedded elements ("social media buttons") of other third parties, such as YouTube, Twitter and Facebook. Such cookies are referred to as "social media cookies" and are used to integrate social media into the website via plug-ins. These third parties may be able to install their cookies on your device and subsequently gather information relating to your online activities, due to the fact that your browser connects to their web servers to retrieve that content.

3. Our cookies

3.1 Joomla Session Cookies

The Website is powered by the Joomla Content Management System (CMS). By default, the Joomla CMS automatically installs a so-called "session" cookie into your web browser as soon as you visit our Website. A session cookie is a temporary cookie that lasts only for the duration of your visit of our Website. It is deleted as soon as you close your web browser. This cookie is used for tracking the existence of your session on the Website and to validate your access to different parts of the Website.

3.2 Google Analytics Cookies

The ITCB® website uses Google Analytics. Google Analytics is a service which uses cookies to help website owners monitor the number of people that visit their website and to analyse how they use it. Google Analytics provides basic information such as how many people have visited a website, which pages they viewed and the average time people spent on a given site.

The information generated by the Google Analytics cookie about your use of the ITCB® website is transmitted to Google and information will be stored by Google on servers in the United States. 3.3 Cloudflare Cookies

The __cfduid cookie is used to override any security restrictions based on the IP address the visitor is coming from.
